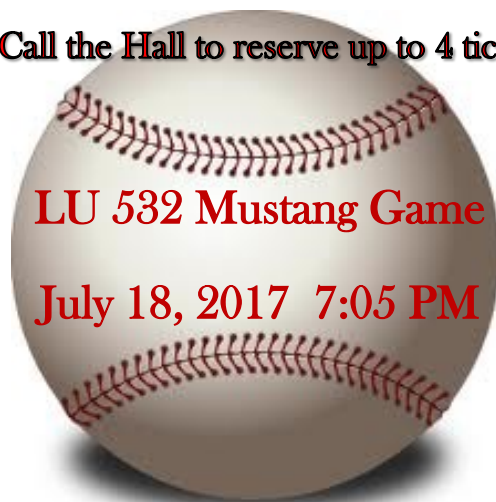

The National Child Identification Program is dedicated to increasing this number and is partnering with professional athletes, faith-based organizations, business and unions to do so

CHILD ID KITS



There is nothing more important to the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers than our members and their families' safety and well-being. To help our members protect their children and grandchildren, the IBEW has joined the National Child Identification Program to provide free Child ID Kits to our members.

A Child ID Kit is a simple, yet effective tool to help families maintain current descriptive information about their children. The kit allows law enforcement authorities to scan the child's fingerprints from the completed Child ID Kit into the National Crime Information Center database, to assist in locating a missing child. Completing the kit is simple—fill out the fingerprint identification card with the most recent information and follow the instructions for the fingerprints and DNA sections. Store the card in a safe place and only turn it over to the authorities in the case of an emergency.
